For the sportscar fan there will be the SPEED Series and for the historic fan there will be not only GP cars from the 1960s and 1970s in the Grand Prix Masters but also historic sportcars from the 1960s and 1970s in the World Sportscar Masters. Allied to that will be the cut and thrust of the best of Caterham racing with the Caterham Superlight R300 championship. BRSCC Competitions Director, Drew Furlong, said "It is a great honour for the Club to be asked to organise this prestigious event at the home of motorsport. Super League is growing in popularity all the time and with a very exciting support package it promises to be a great weekend of racing."

### **\* LIGHTS, CAMERA, ACTION!**

GoPro, the Hero HD camera company, has appointed Ford Racing UK boss Kevin Shortis as a motorsport dealer for their products in the UK. GoPro are the manufacturer and global distributor of the new HD quality in-car video camera. The camera produces 2.5 hours of full quality HD footage on one 16 GB SDHC card. The camera unit is enclosed in a quick release mounting and may be mounted on the suction cup (for glass) or rollbar mount. Apart from video, the camera may be programmed to shoot at 2/5/10/30 and 60 second intervals during the session. Just press the shutter

button once for 2.5 hours of poster-print quality photos. Water proof to 180 feet (60m) and protected from rocks and other hazards thanks to its removable polycarbonate housing. Replacement housings and lens kits are available, making repairs or refurbishing the HD HERO camera affordable and conveniently.

At maximum resolution in 1080p HD a 30 frames per second quality video will be captured and on one charge give 2.5 hours of material.
